- * Al-Başīrah shall be published twice a year (in June & December)
- * Al-Başīrah Research articles for publication will be forwarded for peer review to two nominated referees, one National and two International analysts.
- * Al-Baṣīrah regarding the publication process, the Rules & Regulations of HEC will be implemented.
- * Al-Baṣīrah Decision of the Editorial Board regarding publishing article will be the final.
- * Al-Baṣīrah Editorial Committee reserves the rights of necessary amendments, cancellation and abstract in the articles sent. Editor shall inform the writers with the opinion of the analysts and to make necessary changes.
- * All research articles published in Al-Baṣīrah express the view-points of their authors. So every article is the sole responsibility of the writer whilst Editorial Committee and NIML, Islamabad has no responsibility in this regard.
- * Articles once sent to Al-Başīrah shall not be returned in both the case, published or not published.
- * Al-Başīrah Two copies of Research Journal would be given to each participant.

Rules & Regulations for publishing an Article General Points:

- 1. Article should be composed on one side of A4 paper. It should not be more than 25 pages.
- 2. While composing the article, be careful regarding font sizes:
 - a. For main-headings, font size: 18,
 - b. For sub-heading, font size: 16 and
 - c. For matter, font size: (Urdu & Arabic:14, English:12)
 - d. For foot note, font size:(Urdu & Arabic:12, English:10)
- 3. The article should have not been published anywhere else.
- 4. The article should be in accordance with the research principles and should be on a new topic. Moreover, the article should be adorned with the references of basic sources and should not be infringed.
- 5. It is necessary to take care of secret and rules of writing & spelling.
- 6. Three hard copies and one soft copy are required.
- 7. Author would enclose an abstract containing approximately 250 words.
- 8. Article may be written in the Urdu, English or Arabic languages.
- 9. It is necessary to avoid from errors and omissions.

Directions for Writing & Editing

Thesis should contain the following

1. Abstract

It should contain summary regarding research. Abstract must be written in English language.

2. Introduction

Introduction must include objective, methodology, distinctive characteristics of the research work and conclusion.

3. Keywords

Authors are required to include five key words.

4. Conclusion

Conclusion should be presented in a logical sequence.

5. Discussion

In this part of the article, author would present his views and research in detail.

6. References

References should be made according to the following guidelines:

- i) References should be made as Footnotes.
- ii) While giving references, *Chicago Manual Style* should be adopted.
- iii) While referring to a book, author's name, name of the book, publisher's name & place and year of publication and then Volume No/ Page No should be clearly mentioned.

Following example should be followed:

Ibn Kathīr, Tafsīr Al-Qurān Al-Azīm, Dar al-Sādir, Bayrūt, 1354 A.H, 2/312

- iv) For similar references at multiple locations, traditional style of abbreviations may be used.
- v) Quranic verses in the article be presented in Arabic script.

Method would be as under:

Sura Nisa: 4/184

vi) All Ahadiths should be briefly interpreted.

Example for this is as under:

Al-Bukhārī, Al-Jami' Al-Sahēh, Kitāb al-Ilm, Bāb Ifshā al-salām min al-Islām, Darussalām, Riyad, 1414A.H, Hadith no: 29, 1/8

vii) All-known figures mentioned in the article must be briefly introduced and references from books should also be quoted.
